The writer, Peter O'Donnell, has been writing numerous adventures both as cartoon strips for newspapers and albums, as well as novels. The character Modesty Blaise is a symbol for an independent, strong and very cool woman in the adventure section of books, comics and movies, always very British in a Pop Art way.
